Goal 1: Increase EOC proficiency by 3% in each discipline

For: Low achieving sub groups

Who: EOC Teachers, PLCs, Special Education Teachers, Literacy Coaches,

Curriculum Specialist, Lit Tech members

What: To be determined by EOC/PLC teachers

When: Start 1st semester/End at two year plan

Goal 2: ACT: Increase the number of students who score a seventeen in yearly increments

For: Juniors who take the ACT

Who: Bebe and Gina have made contact with consultants and have made plans to visit a program at a Hendersonville School; 11th graders; guidance counselors; teachers; literacy coach

What: ACT Prep course close to ACT during school

When: close to when the ACT is given; T&L meetings for training and organization

- Bootcamp/prep course
- Teachers will give timed assignments to get students used to the format
- ACT question a day in some classes
- Test-taking skills
- Test anxiety management
- Communicate purpose/advantages of high scores on ACT
