Goal 2: ACT: Increase the number of students who are considered career and college ready as measured by an ACT composite score of 17 by 3 percentage points each year, from 60.1% in 2018 to 63.1% in 2019 and 66.1% in 2020.

Data Monitoring	<p>64% 17 or higher up from 60%</p> <p>Average ACT score is up from 18.5 to 18.8</p> <p>Math scores were visibly higher :)</p> <p>Qualitative: Students are informed, talking about their ACT scores. It seems relevant to them.</p>	<p>Students may need training, Can be done in Boost Camp.</p> <p>Acknowledgement for those who improved scores. Also, meet with students to discuss what next ... steps to increase scores, improve, apply to college.</p> <p>Help students know how to access their scores.</p>

<p>Goal 3: Teacher Professional Development : Improve student instruction by providing teachers with appropriate time to acquire or implement personalized professional development. The percentage of teachers reporting on the NC Teacher Working Condition Survey (Q8.1 b) who agree or strongly agree that they are provided with appropriate professional development will increase from 67% (2018) to meet or exceed the state rate in 2020.</p>
