- You will only have 30 minutes to choose two gifts per child, please arrive no more than 5 minutes before your shopping time
- 6ft social distancing will be in effect while you are shopping or waiting in line
- Masks will be required; you will not be allowed in the store without a mask
- If you make an appointment and you cannot keep it, you must cancel your appointment online and make a new appointment; only scheduled shoppers are allowed in the store
- You will not be allowed to shop at a later date/time due to limited number of people allowed in the store
- If you are not able to shop for your child, a family member can shop in your place. They must provide a signed note by the parent/guardian and provide the children's social security cards/birth certificates.
